

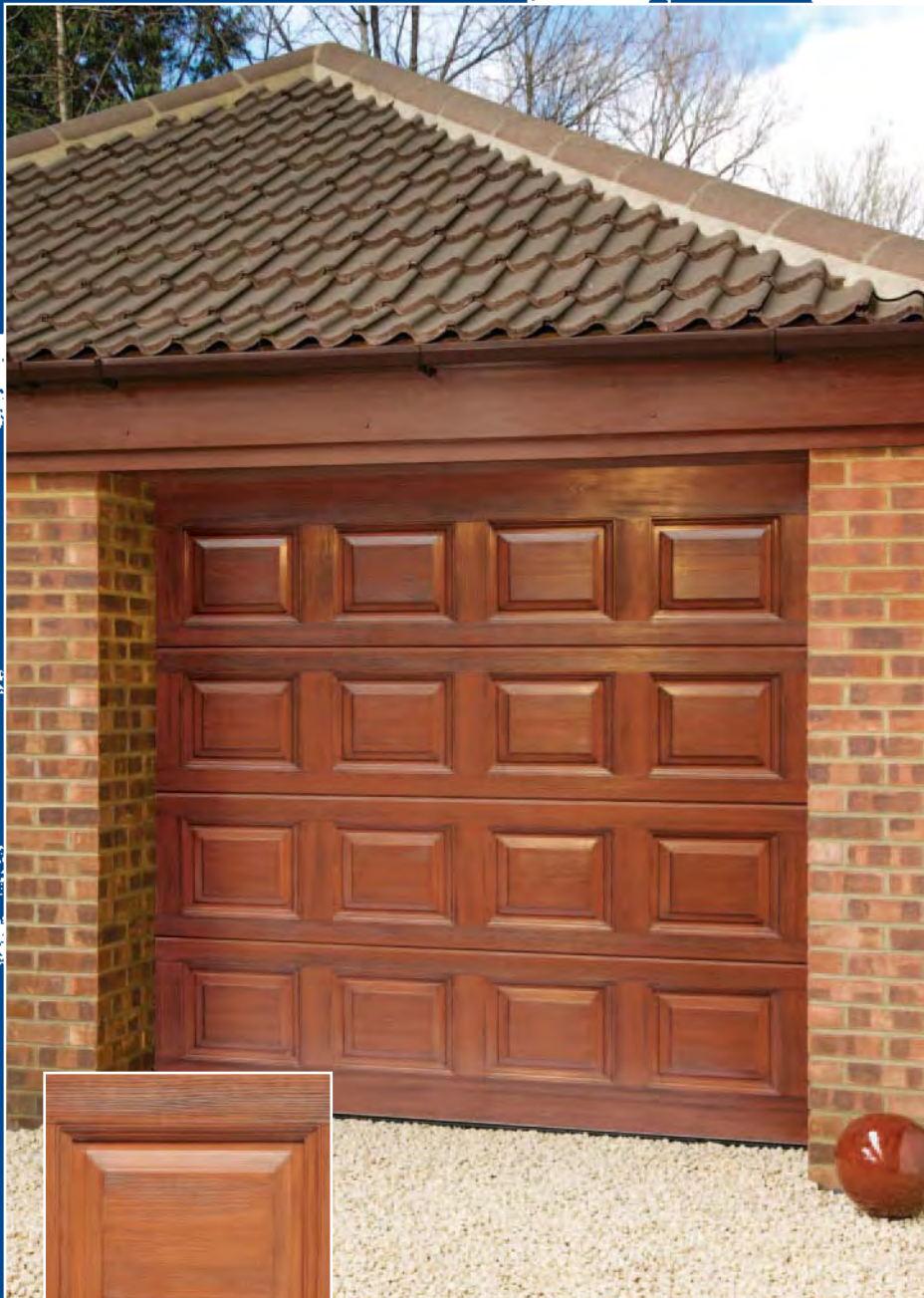

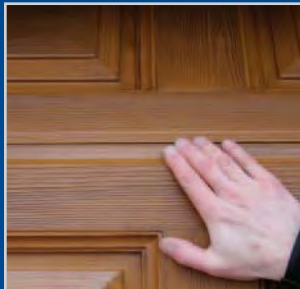

SECTIONAL DOOR GEAR

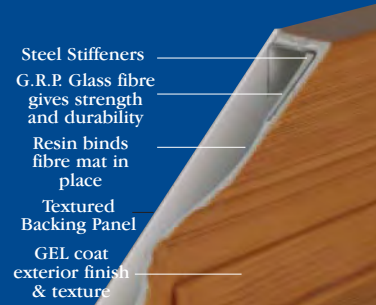
Sectional operating gear is fitted as standard. This provides the convenience of all round weather sealing, vertical lift operation (so you can park right up to the door), maximisation of door width, height and ease of remote control operation.

In operation, doors rise vertically with smooth spring assistance and each 'section' articulates and pivots in turn to run along horizontal tracks back into the garage.

DOUBLE SKIN CONSTRUCTION

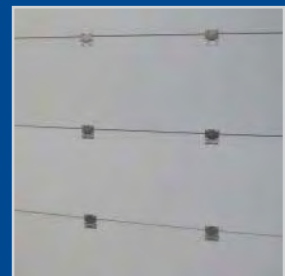
All doors are of double skinned construction giving the doors a very neat appearance to the inside surface. The "40" version of the doors is completed with a rigid foam core which offers the most effective thermal and acoustic insulation available for a garage door.

The reverse side of the doors features clean lines in a light reflecting flat white finish

All doors feature a flat white G.R.P. panel bonded to the rear of the door. Note: doors over 4420mm wide (14'6") have an additional white powder coated bracing attached to the rear of the panels for extra rigidity.

THE VIENNA, OSLO & VERONA

The Vienna, Oslo and Verona sectional garage doors are hand laminated in G.R.P with a three layer resin and glassfibre mat construction, providing impressive strength and rigidity to the door panel. Corrosion protected steel reinforcing is bonded to the panel for extra strengthening and attachment of the operating gear. The double skin construction is achieved with a white G.R.P panel bonded to the rear of the door which conceals the strengthening structure behind the face of the door and gives a neat, light reflecting finish.

The door is constructed from four separate sections which have an integral anti finger-trap design to help prevent accidents when operating the door manually.

Doors are designed for the easy installation of remote control electric operation and are available in single and double sizes in either a crisp Gloss White finish (Vienna only) or a choice of 15 authentic, deep grained, Woodgrain colour finishes. Windows are also available for the Vienna in black mock glazing, or stainless steel 'portholes' for the Oslo as an option.

THE "40" VERSION

The Vienna, Oslo and Verona "40" has all the good looks and operating characteristics of the standard range, but features a fully insulated double skinned insulated construction, which makes it the ultimate sectional garage door.

Integral to the "40" is a flat white G.R.P panel bonded to the rear of the door. This conceals not only the strengthening structure behind the face of the door, but also a 40 mm thick layer of foam insulation, giving the door the highest level of thermal insulation of any garage door available in the U.K.

The rear of the door is finished in white to provide better light reflection*, helping improve brightness levels inside the garage, and features a practical wipe clean surface that is straightforward to maintain and keep looking good.

The insulating foam injected into the panel imparts excellent insulation and sound deadening qualities to the "40" door – particularly important where a garage is used for other home activities than parking a car.

The double skinned box construction of each door section makes them superbly strong and rigid, increasing the resistance to forced entry by attempted break-in through the door panel.

As with the standard door, "40" doors are available in both single and double sizes and in either a crisp Gloss White finish (Vienna only) or a choice of 15 authentic, deep grained, Woodgrain colour finishes. Windows are also available for the Vienna in black mock glazing, or stainless steel 'portholes' for the Oslo as an option.

Hand finished by craftsmen, woodgrain doors are "antiqued" to reproduce the natural subtlety of timber. Please advise if doors are to be fitted side by side to allow doors to be finished as a pair. Each door is unique but pairs will be matched as closely as possible for density of colour and tone.

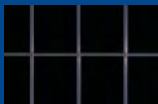

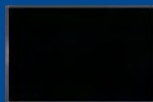

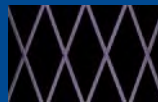

AUTOMATION

DC & "40" DC

Sectional gear is ideally suited to the installation of remote control electric operation, adding convenience, safety and security. This can be further enhanced with options such as the addition of secure key code entry, automatic floodlight illumination of the drive and an opening switch inside the home entrance. Multiple button transmitters enable more than one remote controlled garage door, as well as entrance gates and other security devices to be operated from a single transmitter.

DC-650NIII HomeLink* compatible

Smooth DC motor featuring 'soft start-soft stop' for improved safety and quieter closing. Also features Smart Entry System automated force setting. Patented Reference Point Technology means the opener always knows the precise position of the door and constantly measures and monitors forces for ultimate safety and sensitivity. The operator not only monitors itself, the Doorsafe monitoring feature constantly measures the door's performance and activates the safety systems should the door begin to operate outside the force safety envelope. Energy saving circuitry reduces running costs. Anti-thief backdrive feature gives further protection against unauthorised entry. The DC-650NIII operator is suitable for sectional doors up to 4267mm wide x 2286mm high (14'0" x 7'6")



DC-800NIII HomeLink* compatible

The DC800-NIII shares all the features of the DC650-NIII but has a more powerful motor. It also allows an intermediate close position to be programmed and an adjustable interval for the courtesy light. This operator is suitable for all sectional doors.



The new toothed cable drive is exceptionally quiet.

GENERAL INFORMATION

INSTALLATION

Fitting of the Wessex sectional door range is straightforward and quick. Doors can either be fitted behind an existing timber frame, between the reveal, or alternatively to maximise opening width and height, can be fitted directly to the brickwork behind the reveal, adding up to an extra 6 inches to the overall drive-through clearance.

WARRANTY

For peace of mind, all Wessex G.R.P. sectional garage doors are covered by a comprehensive manufacturer's two year repair or replacement warranty. See back page for full details.

All work carried out under the warranty is handled directly by Wessex's field Service Support Engineers. Details are available directly from Wessex.

SIZES

The range is suitable for garages with opening widths from 6'10" to 16'0" (2083mm to 4877mm) and opening heights 6'6" to 7'6" (1981mm to 2286mm). With made-to-measure sizes available, the range is perfect for almost any garage opening.

HANDLE POSITIONS

All variants are supplied without locking. If ordered as a manually operated door, or locking is required, the 'Manual locking' option must be ordered. The door is prepared for the handle to fit in the first right hand vertical stile, viewed from outside, on the second panel up from the floor.

END STILES

The width of end stiles will vary between doors of the same style of different widths. If precise details are required please enquire prior to ordering.

COLOURS

Colours shown in this publication are for guidance only. For accurate colours please request to see a current sample.

PRODUCT WARRANTY

PRODUCT GUARANTEES

Subject to conditions set out below;

- (a) Wessex garage doors are guaranteed against any form of manufacturing defect for a period of 2 years from the date of original purchase.
- (b) Wessex Garage Doors also guarantee that its garage doors will operate safely and reliably for a period of 10 years from original installation.
- (c) Wessex electric operators are guaranteed against any form of manufacturing defect for a period of 5 years for mechanical elements, motors and transformers and for a period of 2 years for other electronic and radio equipment.
- (d) The Exterior finish is guaranteed to provide an effective weatherproof membrane which will resist perforation of the substrate from the weather side due to corrosion for the periods indicated below.
10 years - GRP
- (e) Colour change or fade to the exterior surface will be limited and uniform for a period of 2 years.

CONDITIONS

1. During the comprehensive 2 year guarantee period Wessex Garage Doors undertake to repair or replace (at its discretion), and without charge, products or components which have suffered any form of manufacturing defect. Claims must be notified within 3 days from the date of delivery or within a reasonable time after discovery of any defect.
2. Products covered by these guarantees must have been purchased through an authorised Wessex garage door distributor or as original equipment attached to a newly built dwelling.
3. The warranties shall apply for normal use only. Normal use constitutes no more than 5 operations (open/close cycles) per day.
4. The warranties offered attach to the Wessex product only and no consequential damages will apply no matter how caused.
5. No liability will be accepted as a result of normal wear and tear, incorrect storage, incorrect handling, faulty installation, incorrect use or wilful damage.
6. Claims under this guarantee must be made through the original supplier and accompanied by relevant documentation indicating the date of purchase (e.g. receipt).
7. Wessex Garage Doors maximum liability shall be the original purchase price inclusive of Value Added Tax at the rate prevailing when supplied.
8. Any product which is the subject of a claim:
 - i) must have been correctly installed in accordance with the installation instructions supplied and thereafter properly maintained by a suitably experienced engineer on a regular basis as set out in the Maintenance and Operating Instructions provided with every door. (Additional copies of these instructions are available by calling 01202 825451). We recommend that regular maintenance is provided by a suitably experienced engineer. See your Yellow Pages for your local Wessex Garage Door or DHF specialist.
 - ii) must have the manufacturers reference number still intact (found on the barcode label on the door)
 - iii) must not have been modified in any way.
9. Claims will not be accepted where the cause is due to:
 - i) impact or mechanical damage suffered during or following installation, e.g. scratches, indentations, tears, scuffs or other surface abrasion.
 - ii) damage or discolouration caused by contact with any form of caustic, abrasive or corrosive substance, fumes, bird droppings, fire, smoke, floodwater, salts, acids, or from exposure to abnormal atmospheric pollution.
10. This guarantee excludes normal wear and tear on items such as cones, cables, spindles, lock cylinders, hinges or springs.
11. Only Wessex original spare parts must be used when required. The use of non-Wessex parts shall invalidate this guarantee. Warranty period for replacement parts is 6 months or the balance of the original warranty period if greater.

12. The Exterior Finish Guarantee applies only to the weatherside surface and where more than 5% of the surface area of the door is affected. Surfaces must be freely exposed to washing by rainfall and kept clear of accumulated dirt and debris and given equal exposure to local environmental conditions and consistent natural lighting conditions across the face of the door. Special attention is drawn to Clause (9) (i).
13. Primed steel doors and basecoat treated timber doors must receive a suitable exterior quality finishing topcoat immediately after installation. This topcoat finish must be applied strictly in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
14. The guarantee period for electric operators excludes batteries, fuses and light bulbs.
15. Parts replaced free of charge become the property of Wessex Garage Doors.
16. Attempted repairs by non-qualified individuals shall invalidate this guarantee.
17. The specific terms of this guarantee shall only apply to products purchased on or after April 2008 within the UK and Eire.
18. Wessex garage doors and associated products are sold subject to the Wessex Garage Doors Standard Terms and Conditions of Sale, copies of which are available upon request. Wessex Garage Doors shall not be liable as a result of any representation, implied warranty or other term or condition or for any consequential loss or damage, costs, expenses or other claims whatsoever except as expressly set out in these Terms and Conditions of Sale.

General Advice

Door Cleaning

Periodically clean the door panel using warm water and a soft cloth or sponge. Allow to dry naturally. Never use detergent, abrasive, caustic or solvent based cleaners as they may damage the door surface. Bird droppings should be removed immediately as these can be particularly caustic.

Customer Maintenance

Moving parts should be lubricated regularly to ensure smooth operation. Every six months visually inspect all wear items (including cables) for signs of wear. If wear is detected we recommend you contact your local Wessex approved service engineer to arrange for a replacement. Garage door springs are under extreme tension and should only be repaired or replaced by a suitably qualified engineer.

Other performance issues affecting Wessex. garage doors are:

Wessex G.R.P doors are individually handcrafted products manufactured to specific customer order. Due to the nature of the product and the hand finishing processes used they may occasionally display small blemishes which do not detract from the overall appearance of the product. These are regarded as being within manufacturers tolerance when such blemishes are not visible to the naked eye when viewed from a distance of three metres. Similarly, Woodgrain effect products will, like the natural material, display colour variations across their surface and colour will vary from door to door. Ordering doors to match helps reduce the variation but will not eradicate it entirely.

Size and Deflection - the natural curing process does not affect the ultimate product size and a tolerance of ± 6 mm on both height and width is deemed acceptable. Up and over doors in the 'open' position will display a level of vertical deflection or 'sag' across the width of the panel and up to 6mm per linear metre is within design tolerance.

These terms and conditions do not affect your statutory rights.
